5. Name two titles of the One who prevailed to open the seals. (Verse 5)

1. Identify the Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse. (Verses 1-8)
2. What will the rider on the red horse take from the earth? (Verse 4)

4. How many people will die during the fourth seal judgment? (Verse 8)
5. What will the kings of the earth try to hide from during the Tribulation Period? (Verse 16)

4. What will happen on earth three times as a result of the last three trumpet judgments? (Verse 13)

6. How many people are in the army that will be loosed by the angels at the Euphrates River? (Verse 16)
7. Identify six sins that will be common during the Tribulation Period. (Verses 20-21)

3. How long will it take to destroy Babylon, consume her riches, and make her desolate? (Verses 10, 17, and 19)
4. Has slavery ceased to exist in the world? (Verse 13)
5. How will those in heaven respond to the destruction of Babylon? (Verse 20)

Questions from Chapter Nineteen:

1. Should people want to attend the Marriage Supper? (Verse 9)
2. Should people worship angels? (Verse 10)
3. What is the rider on the white horse called? (Verses 11 and 13)
4. Are there any animals in heaven? (Verses 11 and 14)
5. How many suppers are mentioned in this chapter? (Verses 9 and 17)
6. Where will the Antichrist and False Prophet spend eternity? (Verse 20)

1. What will happen to Satan as soon as Jesus comes back? (Verses 1-3)
2. How many times is a thousand years mentioned? (Verses 2-7)

5. At the Great White Throne Judgment, if a person's name cannot be found in the book of life, what will happen to them? (Verse 15)

2. What is the name of the holy city that comes from God in heaven? (Verse 2)

5. How will New Jerusalem be lit? (Verse 23)
6. What will people take into New Jerusalem? (Verses 24 and 26)
7. Will unbelievers be allowed in New Jerusalem? (Verses 8 and 27)

Questions from Chapter Twenty-two:

1. Where will the river of water of life come from? (Verse 1)
2. What are the leaves of the tree of life for? (Verse 2)
3. Whose throne will be in New Jerusalem (Verse 3)
4. What will believers have on their foreheads in heaven? (Verse 4)
5. Is the Book of Revelation a book of history or prophecy? (Verses 7, 10, 18 and 19)
6. Who will have access to the tree of life? (Verse 14)
7. What invitation is given by the Spirit and the bride? (Verse 17)
